Classroom Series Course Descriptions

These courses are designed for the traditional classroom approach to post-high school adults. The chapters in each Textbook and Lesson books varies and is written by experienced teachers, scholars, and or very qualified members of the clergy.

BIBLE & THEOLOGY

Biblical Beliefs – Presents foundational Bible doctrines in a popular, easy-to-understand format. Covered in the course is creation and the fall of man, faith and regeneration, justification and adoption, prayer and worship, angel, Satan, resurrection and judgment and the church.

New Testament Survey – Brings unity and chronological sequence to New Testament study by weaving the contents of the books around a central theme – the person of Christ. Divisions are the synoptic Gospels, and Gospel of John, the of Acts, the Pauline Epistles in chronological order, the General Epistles and the book of Revelation.

Old Testament Survey Part I:Genesis-Esther- A sweeping overview of God's working from creation through the early days of His chosen people. Topics include the patriarchs, Israel's trek to the Promised Land, David's reign, Solomon's kingdom, the kingdom of Judah and the exile.

Old Testament Survey Part II: Job-Malachi – The message of the book of poetry and prophecy gives insight into God's dealings with His people. This course relates the great writings of the prophets to us today. It is in chronological sequence to avoid duplication of historical background information.

The Triune God- This course covers the individuality of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit and the biblical teaching of the Trinity. Topics include the character /work of God; the preexistence, incarnation, deity, death, resurrection and return of Christ; and the personality and power of the Holy Spirit.

You & Your Bible – Believers should be well informed about the Word of God. This course presents the inspiration and authorship of the Bible, how it was preserved, why we believe it, how we deal with its problems and critics, the role of archeology, and ways to study the Bible more effectively.

PROPHETIC MINISTRY

Growing In The Prophetic – Will learn valuable resources that provide practical ways for growth and maturity in the prophetic ministry. The student will learn Prophetic administration, revelation, interpretation, application and much more.

Understanding Prophetic People _ The student prophet will learn how to step out of loneliness and isolation and come into balance and wholeness as they grow in this unique calling. This course sheds light on why prophets seem to be extreme and yet so moody, how to her from God, signs of a true prophet and more. This book will give a measure of peace to those who desire to relate to strongly gifted prophets.

The Seer – Is a tool to educate on the gift of foresight and its significance in the lives of God's people. Principles shared will address misconceptions about seeing and the prophetic movement. How does visionary revelation happen and can it be trusted. This book will take you on an insightful journey into the Visionary world and learn to discover the prophetic power of dreams, visions and life under the open heavens. This study will stir up your hunger for intimacy with God.

The Prophetic Intercessor – This study will add needed ammunition to the prayer arsenal to inspire effective fervent prayer from the heart.
