DOCTRINAL STATEMENT

- God is the infinite intimate Spirit, who has revealed Himself as a Trinity in unity, existing ceaselessly as Father, Son and Holy Spirit three persons and yet one God.
- Jesus Christ, the anointed one is the image of the invisible God, He Himself is very God; who took upon Himself our nature, being conceived by the Holy Spirit, and born of the Virgin Mary. He died upon the cross as a substitutionary sacrifice for the sins of the world.
 - He arose from the dead in the same body in which He was crucified; He ascended into heaven in that body glorified. Where He is now, our interceding High Priest. He is coming back and will be seen visibly and will set up His kingdom and will judge the quick and the dead.
- The Bible, including both the Old and the New Testaments, is a divine revelation, the original autographs of which were inspired by the Holy Spirit.
- Man was created in the image of God, but fell into sin, and in that sense is lost; this is true of all men, except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God. Salvation is by grace through faith in Christ who His own self bore our sins in His own body on the tree; the retribution of the wicked and unbelieving and the reward of the righteous are everlasting.
- The church is an elect body of believers baptized by the Holy Spirit into one body, each believer living his/her life in the power of the Holy Spirit; its mission being to witness Jesus Christ, teach and preach the gospel among all nations.
- We believe in the full manifestation of the Holy Spirit and moving in the Five-Fold ministry gifts. That it takes all the gifts to bring about the whole work of the Great Commission
- Therefore the program of Christian training is evangelical and it finds its reason for being and it's goal in bringing the individual to a personal acceptance of Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord, in helping the Christian grow in grace and in the knowledge of our Lord, equipping Christians for more effective service.
